one of the most famous scholars of his time and largely responsible for the reformation in medicine in the 16th century; professor of mathematics, Greek philosophy, and medicine; pioneer in the accurate translation of ancient Greek medical texts into Latin, esp. those of Galen and Hippocrates; published first scholarly work on syphilis, which had only recently appeared in Europe.
